ROOSTERS

If you picked up a craft package, you'll need the wooden rooster, 1-3 cotton balls (save the rest for a later craft), brown string, watercolor paints and feathers. Supplies to find at home: glue, water. If you didn't pick up a craft package, you can try this painting technique on paper!



Get your watercolors wet. (you can drop water on them or use the paint brush to get them wet).



Dip a cotton ball into the paint and press onto the rooster.



Paint the rooster with your cotton balls.



When the paint is dry, glue feathers on and thread the string through the hole.


